Our Mission

SAfA's mission is to improve the lives of young people by:

- Providing **skills training** that leads to meaningful employment in agriculture.
- Strengthening **their entrepreneurial mindset** and economic opportunities.
- Improving access to **youth-friendly health services**, including sexual and reproductive health.

Our Focus Areas

SAfA addresses the root causes of poverty, unemployment, and inequality through three core areas:



Agriculture: Equipping young farmers with skills, tools, and market access to create viable livelihoods.



Education and Logistics: Developing vocational training programs in logistics and supply chain management to prepare youth for market-relevant jobs and strengthening agricultural value chains.



Health and SRHR (Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights): Expanding access to youth-friendly health services, family planning, and awareness campaigns that refer to gender based violence, early pregnancies and Sexually transmittable diseases (STIs).

Our Approach

SAfA's programs combine **collaboration, local ownership, and efficiency** to deliver tailored solutions that address youth challenges holistically. By fostering partnerships with local communities and key stakeholders, SAfA ensures its initiatives are impactful, scalable, and sustainable.

Our Methodology

To achieve long-term impact, SAfA applies a **holistic and collaborative methodology** that maximizes synergies across sectors and stakeholders:

1. **Local Ownership:** Projects are co-created with local communities to ensure relevance and long-term success.
2. **Knowledge Sharing:** SAfA pools and leverages expertise from foundations and local stakeholders to create innovative, effective programs.
3. **Resource Optimization:** Shared resources maximize impact and minimize duplication.
4. **Long-Term Impact:** Programs are designed to continue offering solutions long after project completion.
5. **Measurable Results:** SAfA uses data-driven approaches to track progress and learn from outcomes.

Where We Work

SAfA's current programs focus on addressing youth challenges in two key countries:



Ethiopia: 70,000 young people in the **Amhara** and **Oromia** regions have participated in trainings.



Tanzania: 50,000 young people in **Arusha, Kilimanjaro, Mbeya, and Songwe** are currently enrolled in training activities.
